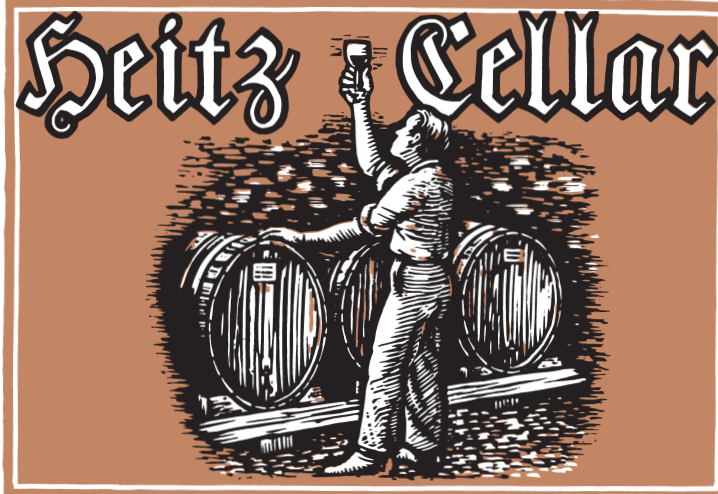

Tasting Notes

The 1998 Martha's Vineyard is identifiable with its pronounced mintiness, a unique characteristic of the vineyard. True to its pedigree, this is a rich, briary wine with layers of complexity. The flavors are bright and bold with a medium weight on the mid-palate and a delightfully soft and lingering finish.

The 1998 vintage shows signs of youthful tannins and tenacity, but the overall balance ensures a long lived wine. This is a solid Cabernet Sauvignon from the cellars of Heitz Wine Cellars.
