Tasting Notes

The 2001 “Trailside Vineyard” Cabernet is a spectacular, densely hued wine combining the impressive characteristics of its Rutherford terroir with the power of the vintage.

A glorious burst of sunripened blackberry with notes of cedar fascinates the nose and fills the mouth with a stunning purity that unfolds in layers of intrigue. This Cabernet is skillfully balanced with polished tannins that usher the rich varietal flavors to a lengthy and unforgettable finish. This classic wine will age gracefully.
