Tasting Notes

The 2000 "Trailside Vineyard" Cabernet Sauvignon is a fabulous wine from the Rutherford appellation in the Napa Valley. This full-bodied Cabernet caters to its fans with bright cherry-like fruit, muscular intensity and artfully balanced flavors. These attributes, interlaced with new oak nuances from French limousin barrels, create a delightful wine. The end result is a richness that is strong and powerful, yet refined, with a wonderful silkiness on the finish.
