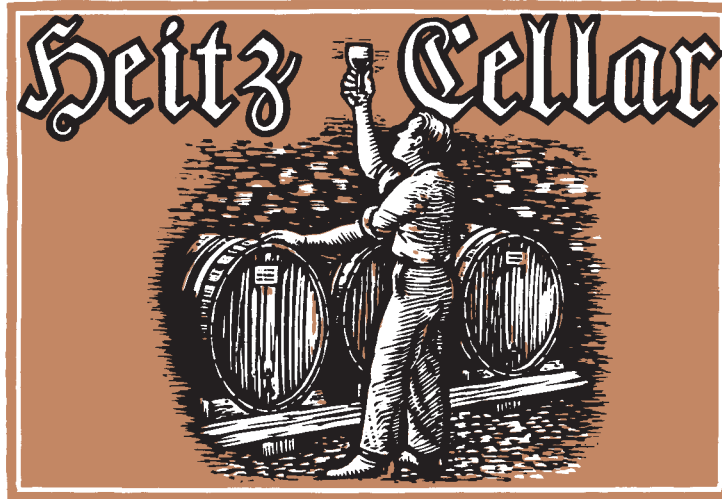

Tasting Notes

From its vibrant purple hue to its lush, smooth finish, the 2003 Trailside Vineyard Cabernet displays the seamless beauty of a Rutherford classic.

Sleek and authoritative, this wine makes an exciting first impression with a lavish bouquet of bold blackberry, dried anise and notes of cedar. It fills the mouth with flavors of dark, brambly fruit wonderfully integrated with French Limousin oak during Heitz extended aging process.

Gracefully balanced with firm tannins and lively acidity, this is a Cabernet you will love from beginning to end. Decant it to enjoy today, or cellar it to treasure for many years to come.
