## 2013 Trailside Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon Rutherford, Napa Valley



### Winemaker's Insight

Since 1986, this outstanding vineyard has been part of the Heitz estate, producing the first Trailside Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon in 1989 and is one of our three, single-vineyard Cabernet Sauvignons. Nestled between the Silverado Trail and Conn Creek on the fertile, eastern side of the Rutherford AVA, only the best vineyard blocks are selected for this earthy, yet delicate wine.

“The silky tannins and tightly wound core of this wine are hallmark signs of this vintage’s aging potential. Blackberry, ripe raspberry, cassis liqueur, and briar notes fill the glass and are complemented by an earthy sweetness that Trailside has become synonymous with. Fresh vanilla, toasted nuts, and baking spice characteristics from the Limousin oak give an elegant lift to the ripe fruit notes.”

### 2013 Vintage

A textbook perfect growing season led to excellent ripening conditions rewarding us with a high-quality crop. The warm spring led to an early bud break, exceptional weather through flowering caused healthy and consistent fruit set, and the weather during the growing season allowed berries to ripen and mature to their full flavor potential. Harvesting our red wines began the second week of September and finished on October 6<sup>th</sup>. When fermentations were complete, we were impressed with the powerful tannin structure these young wines possessed. Heitz Cellar’s long barrel aging regime for our single-vineyard Cabernet Sauvignons softens the structure of these wines to enjoy them upon release, however those with the patience to cellar for 15+ years will see why 2013 is a vintage to remember.
