



2015 Martha's Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon

Hidden in the shadows of the Mayacamas mountains, on the alluvial fan of western Oakville, *Martha's Vineyard* continues to embody the pedigree of being named the first single vineyard designated wine in Napa Valley. Since 1966, Heitz Cellar has organically farmed and vinified the classic style of wine from this historic vineyard. Vintage after vintage, these timeless vinification techniques, combined with the distinct characteristics of the land, create a wine that is unmistakable.

The 2015 Vintage was known for its unusually warm weather which led to reduced yields at harvest. Luckily those reduced yields resulted in impeccable quality of fruit. This vintage expresses great depth of flavor and intensity, which offers a truly memorable wine drinking experience right now and will continue to shine many years in the future.

The Palate of the 2015 is breathtaking and confirms why this is one of the top three sites in the world for the Cabernet Sauvignon grape. No words seem to do justice to the layers of density, freshness, and purity that can be found in the glass. The 2015 somehow achieves the wild, untamed, yet polished nature that very few vintages have been able to reach.
